Life for G.Ps, including female G.Ps, was very different when Kim qualified as a G.P. All were full-time; they had to take their turn of covering a '24/7' NHS service, including visiting homes of patients they knew nothing about in the middle of the night and at weekends, including Christmas Day.

Ever seeking new challenges, Kim has trained and expanded her expertise in dermatology in recent years and has now decided to move into that role full-time. Kim will leave St. Clements on 4th October 2015 and, whilst we will all be very sorry to see her leave, her enthusiasm and enjoyment of her dermatology work and challenges means that patients will continue to benefit from her work and skills.
