

Travel Immunisation Information



- Please allow **at least 6-10** weeks prior to travelling for your vaccination programme.
- Some vaccination programmes may require **up to 3 months** for schedules to be completed.
- Late requests for appointments cannot always be accommodated.

To ensure that we provide you with the correct information and immunisations:

Prior to your appointment, please complete the **Travel Risk Assessment Form** (available on the website or from the Reception desk). And then hand **the form to a member of the Reception team at least a week, before your first appointment.**

PAYMENT: Please note that payment is required for some vaccinations. Please ensure all payments are made **prior** to your consultation with the nurse. We take cash or cheque payments. The costs are on the reverse of this leaflet.

Regarding your Vaccination Appointment:

1. Your first appointment will be 30 minutes where your travel requirements and vaccination schedule will be discussed.
2. You may require more than one appointment to complete your vaccination schedule.
3. St. Clements is a Yellow Fever Immunisation Centre.
